## Creating a full Screen Slide Show

The full screen slide show can be used for a lot of purpose. You can send multiple pictures of your family of school in one file via e-mail or quickly create a slide show of a field trip. The other advantage is that it is created as a PDF file so anyone with Acrobat reader can view your files.

## Steps:

1. Using the File Menu choose Automation/PDF Slideshow.

- 2. Select the images for your slide show. You must select each image not a folder. If you have multiple images you want to select in one folder, hold down the Shift Key and click on each image.
- 3. Choose the Output File. This is where you are going to save the file.

- 4. Name of the file.
- 5. Set how many seconds you want each image to appear.
- 6. If you want it to continue to loop choose the loop option.
- 7. Lastly select the transition between pictures. Unfortunately, you can only have one transition for all of your images.
- 8. Click OK.
- 9. Find your file on your computer and view your slideshow.
